Mrs Gibbs and the School Council have organised some activities for Children in Need on Thursday 15th November. Attached to this newsletter is an information letter.

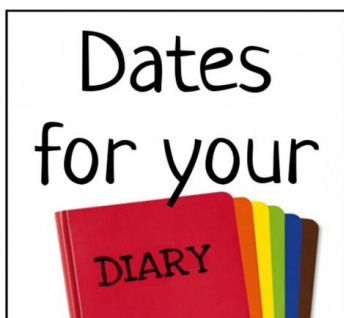
We are grateful for your support as it is a great cause and helps so many disadvantaged children all over the country. Let's see if we can raise over £400 this year!
