The module is being put together offsite and when we have the date for installation, we will let you know. We hope to be able to share the big moment with the children when this happens!



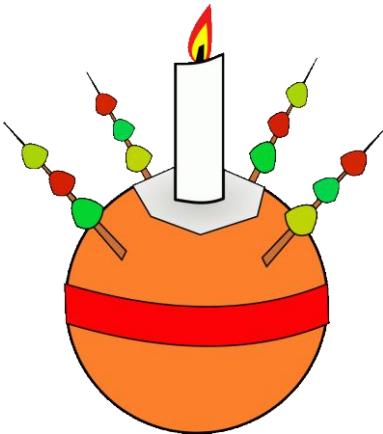
Christingle Service

Thank you for your harvest contributions which have been delivered to the local Food Bank.



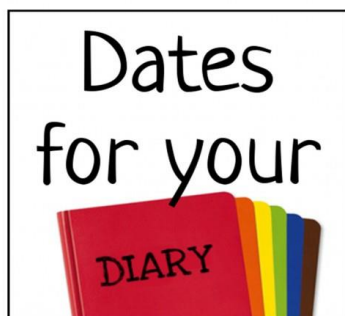
