Cranbrook School Dinners

With immediate effect, school dinners for children in Year 3 through to Year 6 will cost £2.40 per day. We believe this offers great value for money and the quality of the dinners is excellent.

If you are on a low income or in receipt of Job Seekers Allowance, you may be eligible for this benefit that also provides additional funding for school trips and extra-curricular activities the funding can directly benefit your child.
