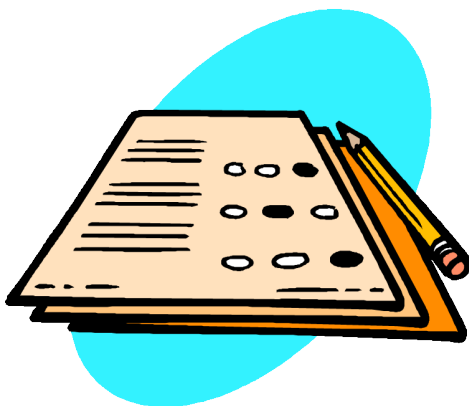
Important Notice

Please can we remind parents that an adult should supervise ALL children after school. Unfortunately, we have had incidents of disruptive and unacceptable behaviour after school recently.

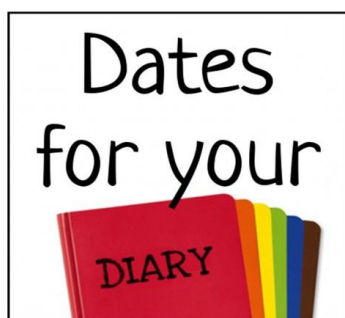
