

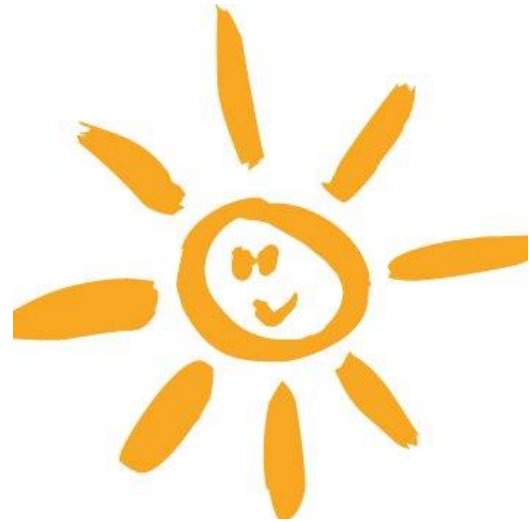

Class 1

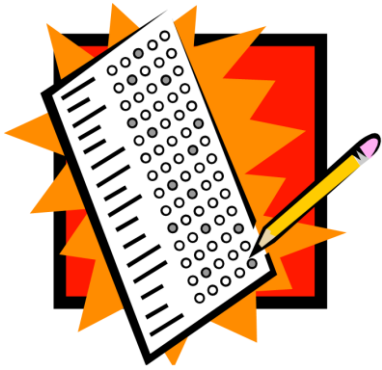
We are pleased to confirm that the modules for the new Class 1 will be arriving on **Tuesday 9th July**.
